Seiwakai Banquet





A Matter of Common Sense and a Matter of Equity

About a half dozen years ago I was describing to one of my classes the common procedures for performing Sanchin Kata at the Seiwakai seminar in Japan. I mentioned that it was typical for the men at the seminar to kneel, remove their gi tops, fold them, and place them on the floor to their right prior to performing Sanchin kata. I mentioned that women kept their gi tops on.

Then, one of my students asked why the gi tops were removed, and I responded that it was to watch for proper posture, proper abdominal breathing, and proper muscle contraction. However, I really wasn't prepared for the question that came next. One of my female students asked: "If the gi top is removed to check for proper posture, breathing, and muscle contraction, then why can't women remove their gi top if they are wearing a sports bra?" Then she followed up by stating: "It isn't as if a woman is exposing anything with a sports bra on."

I stood there thinking for a moment, and all that I could explain was that Japanese culture and US culture are very different. The rules of modesty in Japan are not the same as the rules of modesty here in the US.

Then came the really big question. "Why can't women here in the US take off their gi tops if they choose to and are wearing a sport bra?" I didn't have a good answer that would justify requiring female karateka to wear a gi top if basic rules of modesty were not violated. Sports bras are not revealing, so it seemed like common sense to give my female students the choice of removing their gi top while performing Sanchin kata if they felt comfortable doing so.

To be honest, I haven't had many women students choose to remove their tops during Sanchin kata, but a several have. However, all of my students have the same opportunity to demonstrate the skills that they are acquiring through their practice in Sanchin Kata.

Regarding Sanchin Shime for women, why not? I cannot come up with a good reason to exclude all women from this traditional Goju Ryu practice.





Canada, Mexico, & USA Form North American Karate Federation




The National Karate Federations of Canada, Mexico, and USA signed a memorandum of understanding to form the North American Karate Federation (NAKF), a regional subset of the Pan American Karate Federation (PKF). Federation presidents Craig Vokey (CAN), Samantha Deciderio (MEX) and Elisa Au (USA) signed the MOU during the North American Cup, held April 5, 2023, in Las Vegas, Nevada.

The NAKF will aim to increase collaboration in the region, with plans to organize tournaments, training camps and other events to strengthen the national teams. NAKF also plans to extend collaboration with other countries and regional federations, to advance karate in North America. Also in attendance at the North American Cup was Dr. Jose Garcia Maañon, President of the Pan American Karate Federation and 1st Vice President of the WKF. Also Mr. Tony Mendez, PKF Treasurer and WKF Executive Committee member.

66 athletes representing Canada, Mexico, and USA competed in the 2023 North American Cup. First place winners in each category qualified directly for the 2023 Pan American Games in Santiago, Chile later this year. The final qualifying event will be held in May in San Jose, Costa Rica.



Dear Karateka,

I would like to invite you to Goju Ryu Seiwakai Seminar in Wołów on June 16-18. The seminar is led by Shihan Gurmit Singh 7th Dan, Co-Director for Europe and UK Seiwakai, President, appointed by Leo Lipinski and Hanshi Fujiwara Sensei. Amrit Singh, son of Shihan Gurmit, is also invited as a training assistant.

Shihan Gurmit Singh is an eminent Teacher and Karateka who in the late 70's to the first half of the 80's trained and lived in the Dojo of the famous Shihan Gogen Yamaguchi. In the late 80's Shihan Gurmit Singh, asked to represent the prestigious IKGA within the United Kingdom (International Karate-do Gojukai Association).

Shihan Gurmit Singh had the good fortune and honor to learn from Shihan Gogen Yamaguchi himself, and trained in personalized training sessions with Shihan Sakomoto and took part in regular high-level group classes.

Around 1986, Shihan Gogen Yamaguchi wrote a letter to Shihan Gurmit Singh to contact Shihan Leo Lipinski, who was flying to London. Shihan Gurmit invited him to his Dojo in Southall, where Shihan Leo Lipinski was very impressed with the high training standards of his students in the Dojo. Since then, they have remained on friendly terms with each other, visiting each other regularly and discussing Karate-Do. Soon after, they, together through discussions with Shihan Shuji Tasaki left the IGKA and formed Seiwakai Goju Ryu Karate-Do International.

All the accommodation has been well arranged. I will let you know the exact number of participants as soon as possible.


On 16th Aug 2023, I will visit Osaka with some of students to join the JKF Gojukai seminar and Tournament.
